  - a. Thank you to the teachers and staff for the desserts provided for the PAWS meeting
- II. New Business
  - A. President's Report (Anna Sappington)
    - a. Discussed removing some events in order to have fewer, more broad events to have a more concentrated volunteer effort
      - i. Removed Kidstuff, one Barnes & Night, Restaurant Fundraisers, Gift Wrap Sale
    - b. Introducing Booster - athon
      - i. Has been successful at Myers
    - c. Jon White – Safety and Security Manager

      - ii. No unplanned fire drills this year

- C. 2018/19 Budget: Review and Vote (Carrie Silver)
- a. Discussed Chaperone Grant Program – designated funds to help refund the costs for chaperones to attend a trip, i.e. cost for trip and cost to take off work
    - i. \$2300 to fund the minimum number of chaperones
      - 1. Christina Kou first to approve , Lydia Palakawski second to approve, all attendees approved
  - b. Discussed Gifts to the School that were proposed by Principal Robinson – total of \$9627
    - i. Anna Sappington first to move to approve; Tammy Montroy – second to approve and all attendees approved
- D. Changes to Recess Procedures (Principal Robinson)
- a. Maximize indoor and outdoor recess time
    - i. Lunch is before every recess
    - ii. Students have the option to get 10 more minutes of recess time each day after 20 minutes of eating time.
    - iii. An individual can leave and must practice “Leave no trace”
    - iv. Results in 25 minutes of recess
    - v. 3 lunch aides are being used
      - 1. Paraprofessionals have not had to be pulled
    - vi. Aides do check to see if lunch has eating their food
  - b. Indoor recess – toys are placed on cafetorium so students can play board games after 20 minutes of lunch time, there is time to play for 10 minutes within the cafetorium, children are then dismissed to they can go to their classroom
